#### The Realm

Drakva - a creature the size of a rhino, as agile as a cheetah with six legs and a giant hornet type head whose bulbous eyes can look in all directions. Its alligator type mouth craves human flesh and it can either talk or communicate telepathically. Varconians - an honourable warrior race who stand eight feet tall with green scaly skin three eyes and a rhino type horn that protrudes from the centre of their forehead.

Layhos - petite in build with pale, lilac coloured skin. This athletic race has a military ethos and they are trained from young in martial arts.

Every seven years the realms two giant moons eclipse one another. This event is known as the Great Merging and is almost upon us. As, on this occasion, the red moon of Morlock, which symbolises evil, will be more dominant than the green moon of Endorf, representing good, this can be a time of many dangers.

After the death of Queen Izobella the infant Princess Rhiannon was to take the throne while the high priestess would rule until Rhiannon's coming of age. At the coronation ceremony the sceptre of Laviston was dropped and its headpiece, the mystical crystal of Shetraza detached. In this instant the darkness that had been banished for a millennium returned. The infant princess was stolen along with the sceptre and crystal and Lavania had vanished. Unless this can be put right by the time of the Great Merging, Zitar the lord of darkness will rule the realm for all eternity.
